Work of the Salvation Army in the
Commonwealth of Australia

TO ALL TO WHOM these presents shall come WILLIAM - -
BRAWELL BOOTH of the City of London General of the Salvation
Army SENDS GREETING -
WHEREAS in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty five
William Booth commenced preaching the Gospel in a tent erected
in the Friends Burial Ground Thomas Street in the Parish of - -
Whitechapel in the County of Middlesex England and in other - -
places in the same neighbourhood AND WHEREAS a number of people
were formed into a Community or Society by the said William Booth
for the purpose of enjoying religious fellowship and in order to
continue and multiply such efforts as had been made in the Tent
to bring under the Gospel those who were not in the habit of -
attending any place of Worship by preaching in the open air in
Tents Theatres Music Halls and other places and by holding other
Religious services or meetings AND WHEREAS at the first the said
Society was known by the name of the East London Revival Society
and afterwards as the East London Christian Mission AND WHEREAS
other Societies were afterwards added in different parts of - -
London aforesaid and a Society was also formed at Croydon near
London aforesaid AND WHEREAS the names of these United Societies
were then altered to that of the Christian Mission AND WHEREAS
the said Society called and known as the Christian Mission was
on or about the First day of January One thousand eight hundred
and seventy nine with a view to more beneficially extending its
operations renamed and has been since that time and is now usually
known as "The Salvation Army" AND WHEREAS the said William - -
Booth held the supreme office in the said Christian Mission under
the title of the General Superintendent thereof and held the -
corresponding office in the said Salvation Army under the title
of "General" thereof AND WHEREAS the said William Booth died
on the Twentieth day of August One thousand nine hundred and -
twelve having by a Deed Poll under his Hand and seal dated the
Twenty first day of August One thousand eight hundred and ninety
in exercise of the power in that behalf vested in him appointed
the said William Brawell Booth to be his successor in the office
of the General of the Salvation Army who by Deed Poll under his

hand and seal dated the Twenty third day of August One thousand nine hundred and twelve duly accepted the said office AND WHEREAS in connection with and as the outcome of the work teaching and experience of the Salvation Army in the United Kingdom and in Australia and in other countries of the world the said late - - William Booth and the said William Bramwell Booth as the present General have evolved and promulgated various operations for the social moral and temporal welfare and improvement of the poorer - and more needy classes of society and of persons who are destitute or vicious or feeble-minded or suffering from injury or sickness or ill-health or orphans or other children needing care in - - orphanages or reformatories and for other charitable purposes - which operations are generally known and described as the Social Work of the Salvation Army and which in relation to the Commonwealth of Australia (hereinafter called "the said Commonwealth") are - hereinafter sometimes referred to as "the Social Work" AND WHEREAS in connection with the carrying on of the Social Work in the said Commonwealth the said late William Booth and the said William - Bramwell Booth as his successor in office have acquired the real and personal property particularised in the schedule hereto and other real and personal property will hereafter be acquired for the purposes of the Social Work and it is right and desirable - that the same respectively should be kept distinct from the other or proper real and personal property of the Salvation Army and - be used and devoted exclusively in and to the Social Work in or connected with the said Commonwealth and that the Social Work - should be defined and regulated and the trusts of the said real - and personal property already acquired and hereafter to be acquired for or in connection therewith declared as hereinafter appearing NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESS that the said William Bramwell Booth BOTH HEREBY DECLARE as follows that is to say

1. The said real and personal property particularised in the said schedule hereto and all property real or personal which may hereafter be acquired by gift grant purchase or in any manner whatsoever for the purposes of the Social Work in or in connection with the said Commonwealth and all real and personal property for

the time being representing the same or any part thereof respectively (all which are sometimes hereinafter collectively referred to as "the trust property") shall at all times hereafter be held upon trust to use and apply the same and the income thereof for the social moral and temporal welfare and improvement of the poorer and more needy classes of society and of persons who are destitute or vicious or feeble-minded or suffering from injury or sickness or ill-health or orphans or other children needing care in orphanages or reformatories in the said Commonwealth and for other charitable purposes in or in connection with the said Commonwealth in such ways and by such means as the said William Bramwell Booth or other the Director (as hereinafter defined) for the time being of the Social Work shall at any time or from time to time think fit PROVIDED ALWAYS that the substantial or principal use and destination of the trust property and the income thereof shall be for the benefit of persons in or belonging or proposing or intending to belong by residence connection or otherwise to the said Commonwealth or some part thereof PROVIDED ALSO that any persons originally objects of the Social Work or any descendants of any such persons although they may fail or cease to belong to any part of the said Commonwealth shall not thereby necessarily fail or cease to participate in the benefits and advantages of the Social Work.

2. The Social Work shall at all times hereafter be under the oversight direction and control of the person who is for the time being the General of the Salvation Army and he shall be called in relation to the Social Work the Director of the Social Work (hereinafter referred to as "The Director") and it shall be his duty to determine and enforce the laws and to superintend the operations of the Social Work and to conserve the same and the trust property for the purposes of the trusts hereby declared PROVIDED ALWAYS that for the purpose of identifying and earmarking the trust property and the income thereof and keeping the same distinct from all property of the Salvation Army full accounts of all monies contributed collected or received for the Social Work and of the application thereof shall be kept in such

manner as to keep the same always distinct and separate from the property of the Salvation Army and that all conveyances - - leases transfers assignments and assurances made to the Director for the time being for the purposes of the Social Work shall be expressed to be made to him as such Director and shall thereupon become subject to the trusts of these presents and that whenever any property real or personal acquired for the purposes of the Social Work shall be conveyed leased transferred assigned or - assured to any Trustees or Trustee other than the Director for the time being such Trustees or Trustee shall in each case - - execute a sufficient declaration of trust so as in every case to enable the property conveyed leased transferred assigned or - assured to be sufficiently identified or ear-marked as being - property devoted to the purposes of the Social Work.

3. The Director for the time being shall have the following further powers

- (a) To expend give away invest or otherwise dispose of - or deal with in such manner as he shall think fit for the purposes of the Social Work or of any portion thereof all or any monies for the time being and from time to time - forming part of the Trust property or the income of the trust property.
- (b) In his absolute discretion to accept purchase take or lease hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal - - property whatsoever and wheresoever or any estate or - - interest therein for the purposes of the Social Work.
- (c) To build alter or pull down any buildings on or - otherwise improve any freehold or leasehold land forming part of the trust property.
- (d) To sell exchange mortgage lease or otherwise dispose of deal with or turn to account any of the trust property real or personal and to reserve/^{or create} easements rights or - - privileges thereover or therein.
- (e) To give good receipts and discharges for any purchase or mortgage money or any other money or property And no vendor lessor purchaser mortgaged lessee or other party dealing with the Director for the time being shall be -

concerned or entitled to enquire as to the expediency or propriety of the transaction in question for the - - purposes of the Social Work.

(f) To cause the trust property or any part or parts thereof to be assured to or vested in any Trustee or Trustees other than or in conjunction with himself and every person in or on whom any such property real or personal may thereby be vested or devolve shall hold the same upon trust to dispose of deal with and use - the same as the Director for the time being shall - - - determine.

(g) At any time and from time to time to revoke by - writing the powers and authorities conferred on any such trustee or trustees aforesaid and to require him or them to assure to or vest in him the Director for the time - being all and singular the property assured to or vested in any such trustee or trustees as aforesaid.

(h) To delegate any powers or trusts given to or reposed in him by these presents to any such person or persons and upon any such terms (including power to sub-delegate) as he shall think fit Provided always that every such delegation or appointment shall be revocable and may be cancelled at pleasure by the Director who made the same or by any succeeding Director.

4. The Director for the time being shall annually publish a duly audited statement of the assets and liabilities of the trust created by these presents.

5. Arrangements may be made between any other branch or - branches of the Salvation Army and the Social Work (but only for what in each case shall amount to a full and sufficient valuable consideration) for the purchase sale exchange lease hire loan of or other dealing with any real or personal property and the - - amount or such consideration and the other terms of any such purchase sale exchange lease hire loan or other dealing shall be determined or approved in such manner as the Director for the - time being shall with regard to any case or class of cases - - determine.

6. If in any case or class of cases property shall be used persons employed or monies expended partly for the other purposes of the Salvation and partly for the purposes of the Social Work a proper apportionment shall be made or contribution fixed so as to fairly charge the other funds of the Salvation Army and the funds of the Social Work respectively in respect of such common user employment or expenditure having regard to the circumstances of each case and every such apportionment shall be made and contribution fixed in such manner as the Director for the time being shall with regard to any case or class of cases determine.

7. In case it shall at any time or times hereafter appear to the Director for the time being that the trusts of these presents or of any or all of the trust property can be advantageously extended altered or modified in some manner not wholly inconsistent with the main object hereof he shall be at liberty with the express consent in writing of five of the Commissioners for the time being of the Salvation Army of whom one at least shall be a Commissioner for the time being in Australia or some territory or portion of Australia to extend alter or modify any such trusts accordingly by any deed or deeds which deed or deeds shall however be revocable with the like consents aforesaid.

8. These presents shall be deemed to have been executed and to have come into operation on the First day of October One thousand nine hundred and nineteen and since that date the Social Work shall be deemed to have been carried on under and subject to the trusts and provisions of these presents and the Director for the time being shall as from the said date undertake all the obligations of the General of the Salvation Army to the staffs engaged in the Social Work and take over and discharge the debts and liabilities then owing and which have subsequently been incurred on or in connection with the said real and personal property particularised in the said schedule hereto and all other the debts and liabilities existing or current on the said date or subsequently incurred in connection with the Social Work and current outgoings shall if necessary be apportioned on the said date.

9. It is hereby declared that in the net value of the -
freehold and leasehold properties particularised in the said -
schedule hereto there is included the sum of Ninety thousand -
four hundred and twenty five pounds thirteen shillings and - -
eleven pence contributed to the Salvation Army for the Social -
Work.
